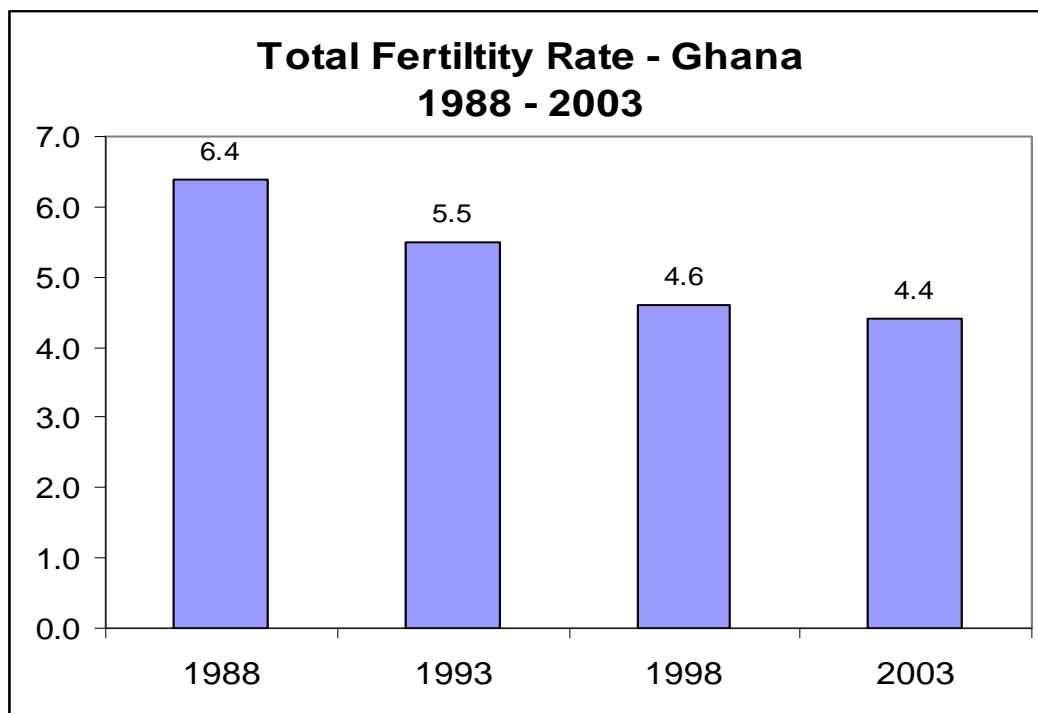

## **1.0 INTRODUCTION**

### **1.1 The Policy Thrust For 2005**

The Ghana Health Service continues to maintain its focus on its five strategic objectives in line with the overall Health Sector Five Year Programme of Work (2002 – 2006).

These are:

- Improving access (geographical and financial) to basic health services
- Improving quality of care
- Improving efficiency
- Improving collaboration
- Improving financing of health services

These objectives are being pursued in line with the focus of the Ghana Poverty Reduction Strategy, which underscores the need for targeting the poor and vulnerable in the development and implementation of health programmes. In line with this focus the Ghana Health Service will continue to intensify efforts aimed at bridging the inequality gaps in access to quality health services.

In 2005, specific efforts will be made at addressing specific issues identified as contributing to the decline in performance with respect to child health services while maintaining a holistic approach to family health services. Efforts will be made at reducing the Burden of Malaria, Tuberculosis, Guinea worm, HIV/AIDS and other communicable diseases. New health service demands such as the increasing burden of non-communicable diseases will be tackled in a more strategic manner. Specifically the Ghana Health Service will continue to improve quality of care outcomes and focus on the expansion of priority public health interventions to ensure that targets are met. The strong demands for scaling up of priority interventions and its implications for resources will be addressed from both macro and micro planning perspective.

There is therefore the need to address areas of dysfunction within the health sector from a management and human resource development perspective. Support systems will be primed up to support service delivery and the human resource challenge will receive increasing attention in a more decentralized manner.

- Improve control of Non Communicable Diseases
- Improve financing arrangements that protect the poor
- Enhance performance measurement, monitoring and use of information to improve productivity in the sector

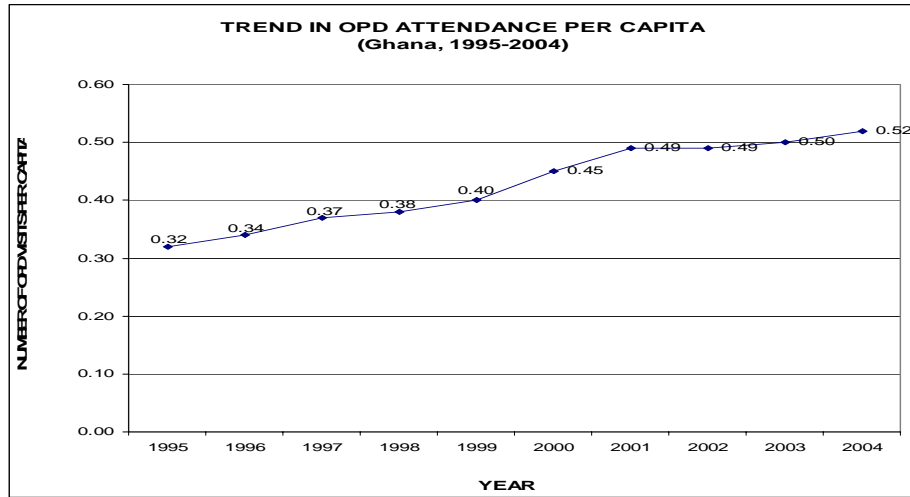

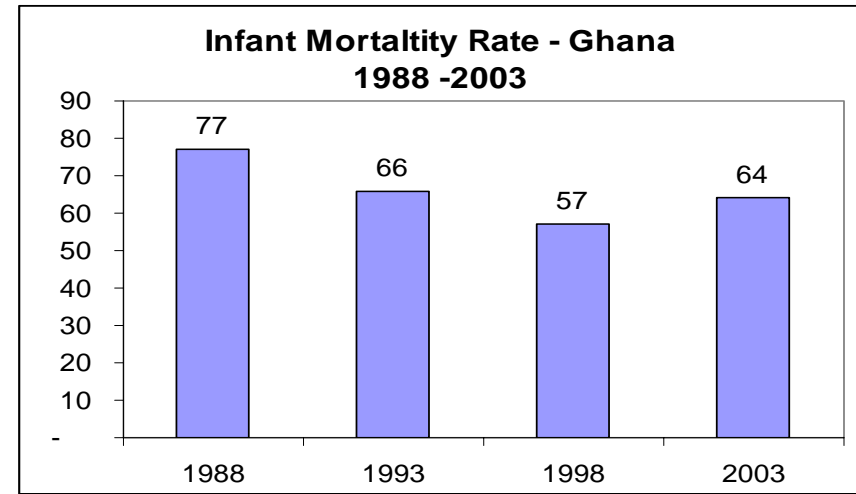

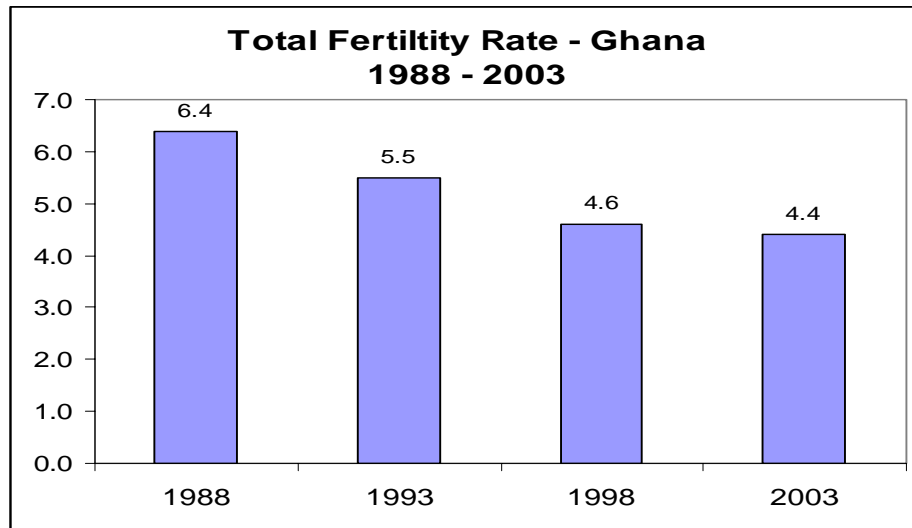

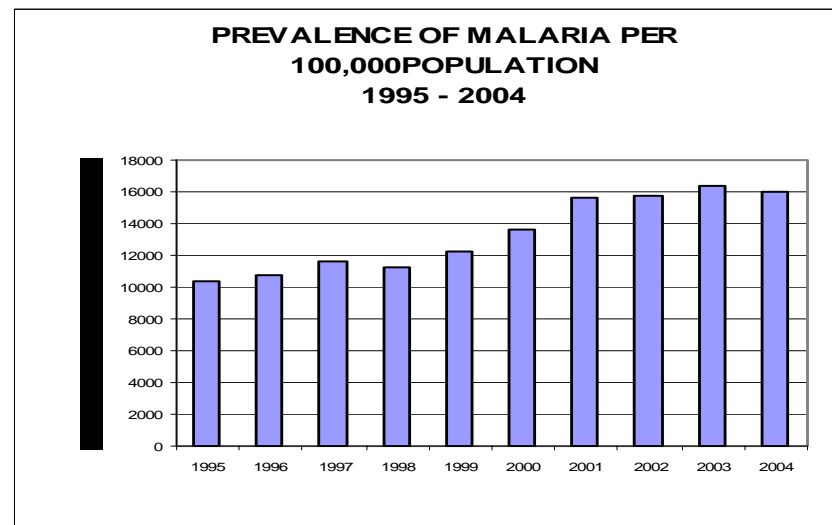

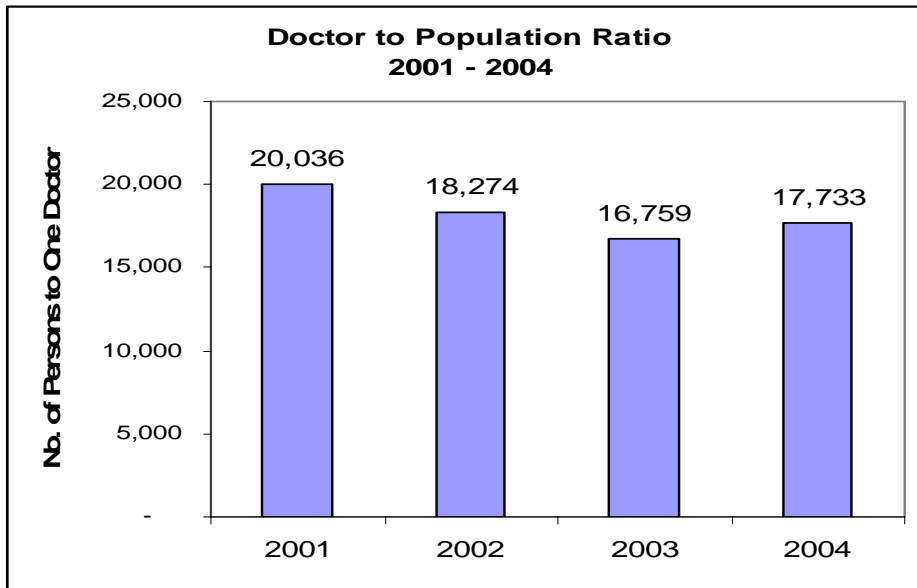

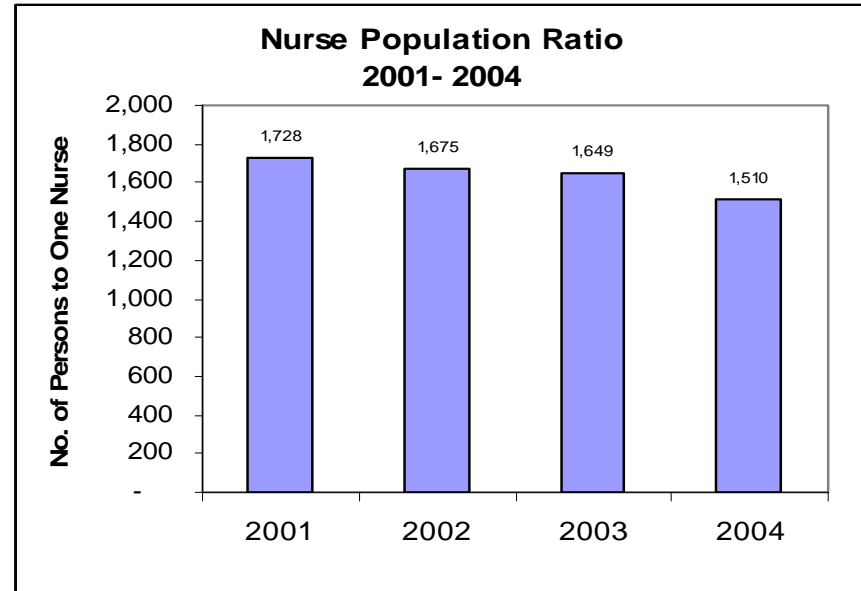

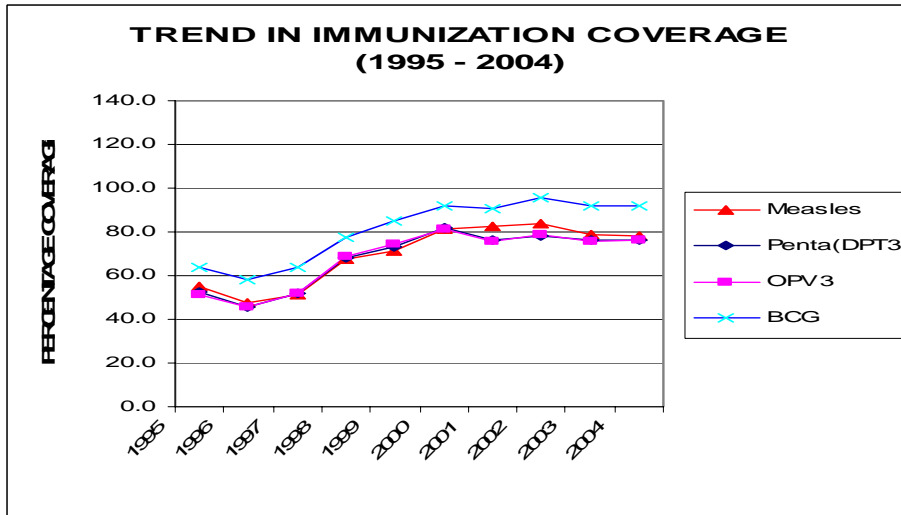

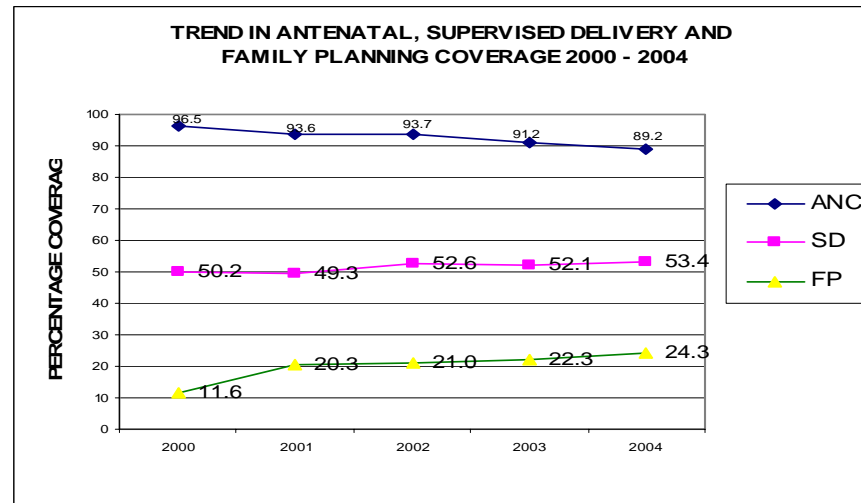
